START NUMBERS THURSDAY AND FRIDAY

Horses may start in one class per day in Ring 1 Thursday and Friday (excl those also entered in teams) If a horse starts in Ring 1, it cannot start in Ring 2 the same day.

If you need a Ring 2 start (e.g. Rising Stars), please don't enter Ring 1, you will be asked to choose.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS

Definitions and Further Nomination conditions for:

FUTURE STARS for Horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition, there is no point restriction. Horses competing in the Futurity cannot compete in the Mini Prix. Any Horse that has started in a World Cup Class cannot compete in any Future Stars, Futurity or Stars of the Futures classes.

MINI PRIX horses cannot compete in the Grand Prix.

RISING STARS is for horses 7 years and under on the first day of the show . The Final will be approx 120cm

EA ATHELETE AGE RULES

Children – Riders are considered children from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 10 up until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.

Junior – Riders are considered Juniors, from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years old.

Young Rider – Riders are considered Young riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years old.

Amateur - Riders may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.

AMATEUR ATHLETES may compete as Amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who: Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing • In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying competition or in a 5* 3 day event/ 4* 3 day event prior to 2021. • Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years • Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first RD is higher than 1.20m at that event. • Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first RD is higher than 1.20m at that event.

A,B,C CLASSES

Horses may only start in a class marked a or b and not both. a,b,c classes will run concurrently with Jump offs if applicable running at the end of the b class for both divisions unless otherwise advised.

CLASSES WITH QUALIFYING SERIES – Being Foxhunter and Rising Stars

Points will be allocated for Rounds 1 and 2. The leaderboard from Qualifier 1 and 2 will determine the top 40 of entrants in the Foxhunter and the top 30 in the Rising Stars who will be eligible for the final. Placings in the final will determine the overall winner.

TEAM SPECTACULAR will be run over 1 round with 4 riders per team, 3 best scores to count.

Teams pay a team nomination fee and are free to choose their own combination of riders.

Being 1 Young Rider and 3 Senior Riders.

YR jumps 135cm, Senior jump 145cm with a tighter time allowed

If teams are on equal first place penalties after Round 1, one senior rider from each team will jump off.

Minor placings will be on penalties only so potentially could have equal 2nd 3rd etc.

Dress code will be white/light colored matching breeches and matching polo shirts.

Teams have to supply own uniforms and are encouraged to get sponsors logo, team name etc. put on.

Speed for Young Riders will be 350 mpm. Speed for Seniors will be 375mpm

This event will run under EA/FEI rules. The Organising Committee (OC) Boneo Park and GDP reserves the right to change or amend the program at their discretion. REGISTRATION AND LICENCES

All riders and owners must be current financial members of EA with no exception. All horses and ponies competing in classes over 105cm must hold current EA registration and jumping licenses. Horses and ponies competing in classes 104cm and under must hold a base registration. Entry checks will be undertaken.

PRIZE MONEY

All prizemoney will be paid by direct deposit to the nominated bank account of the rider the week following the event. Please ensure you enter your Bank details into the Equipe Entry portal prior to entering. The OC WILL NOT chase you for your bank details this year. It is your responsibility to ensure this is entered correctly in your profile.

SCRATCHINGS AND REFUNDS

Scratching's received before close of entries (5pm, 2nd February 2025) or earlier when classes are full, will receive a full refund of entry fees, less \$50 admin and medical fee. • Scratching's after the close of entries (5pm, 2nd February 2025) will receive a 50% refund of entry fees and less the full \$50 admin and medical fee, on presentation of a medical or veterinary certificate (certificates must be received by 5pm 12th February 2025). •

After the commencement of competition (7.30am 13th February 2025), there will be no refunds. Scratching's will only be accepted by email to admin@gdpclassic.com.

The OC reserve the right to adjust the scratching policy if classes fill earlier than close date.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

PERSONAL CONDUCT

A person may not • use indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening language • behave in an offensive or indecent manner • cause serious alarm or affront to a person by disorderly or unsafe conduct • obstruct a person in the performance of that person's work or duties • Boneo Park management do not tolerate the use, transfer or possession of illegal drugs on the premises. • Anyone found using, transferring or in possession of any non-prescribed illegal drug will be ejected and may be handed over to the police.

RIDING CONDUCT

Approved and tagged safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding • The FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse must be abided by at all times • Smooth soled and heeled boots are worn. • Riding of unsaddled or unbridled horses is prohibited • Alcohol must not be consumed prior to riding • Arena etiquette is observed e.g.: • Left hand to left hand • Walking give right of way • Diagonal changes have right of way • Uncontrolled horses are removed from the arena

RIDER WAIVERS

Any riders who have not entered an Event at Boneo Park in the past 12months MUST come to the office to fill out a waiver before riding. Riders will be checked.

Generally this is processed electronically when entering Boneo Park own events, however as GDP Classic Incorporated is a separate entity manual waivers will need to be filled out for any riders who have not competed at Boneo Park in the previous 12 months.

SCOOTERS

Helmets must be worn at all times whilst riding a scooter. Scooters must only be ridden at 'walking pace' and are not to be ridden down the main Boneo Park driveway. Horses have right of way at all times and scooter users must take all reasonable steps to ensure they do not spook horses.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times.
Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition arenas.
