Please ensure the safety of your children whilst in proximity to horses.

Event Cancellation due to COVID or other circumstances outside of organiser control

In the situation whereby the event has to be cancelled due to circumstances outside of the organisers control will receive a full refund less the \$50 admin and medical fee to cover costs already incurred up to the date of cancellation.

Starts per horse

Horses may only start in a maximum of 2 Classes per day.

Release and Indemnity

You acknowledge that horse riding, working with or being around horses can be dangerous. Horses can act in sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt. As a consequence, there is a real risk of damage to property, serious injury or even death. Scratching / Refunds of Entries

Scratchings received before close of entries (5pm, 2nd February 2024) or when classes are full, will receive a full refund of entry fees, less \$50 admin and medical fee. • Scratching's after the close of entries (5pm, 2nd February 2024) will receive a 50% refund of entry fees and less the full \$50 admin and medical fee, on presentation of a medical or veterinary certificate (certificates must be received by 5pm 14th February 2024). • After the commencement of competition (7.30am 15th February 2024), there will be no refunds. Registration and Licences

Registration and licenses All riders and owners must be current financial members of EA with no exception. All horses and ponies competing in classes over 105cm must hold current EA registration and jumping licenses. Horses and ponies competing in classes 104cm and under must hold a base registration. Entry checks will be undertaken.

Prize money

All prizemoney will be paid by direct deposit to the nominated bank account of the rider the week following the event. Please ensure you enter your Bank details into the Equipe Entry portal prior to entering.

Definitions and Nomination conditions for:

Future Stars for Horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs from the date of birth at the time of competition, there is no point restriction. Horses competing in the Futurity cannot compete in the Mini Prix. Any Horse that has started in a World Cup Class cannot compete in any Future Stars, Futurity or Stars of the Futures classes.

Mini Prix horses cannot compete in the Grand Prix

Young Rider An Athlete is considered a Young Rider from the commencement of the year of their 16th birthday until the end of the year of their 21st birthday. Riders of the correct age may compete in both Junior and Young Rider but on different horses. Horses may only compete in either Junior or Young Rider not both.

Junior An Athlete is considered a Junior Athlete from the commencement of the year of their 12th birthday until the end of the year of their 18th birthday. Riders of the correct age may compete in both Junior and Young Rider but on different horses. Horses may only compete in either Junior or Young Rider not both.

Children An Athlete is eligible for the Children's Championships from the commencement of the year of their 10th birthday until the end of the year of their 14th year.

Amateur Athletes may compete as Amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who: Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing • In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying competition or in a 5* 3 day event/ 4* 3 day event prior to 2021. • Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years • Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event. • Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event.

Rising Stars Rising stars is for horses 7 years and under on the first day of the show . The Final will be approx 120cm.

Horses in age classes

For horses 6 years old on the day of the event (actual DOB), For horses 7 & 8 years old on the day of the event (actual DOB).

a,b classes eligibility

GDP

Horses may only start in a class marked a or b and not both. a,b classes will run concurrently with Jump offs if applicable running at the end of the b class for both divisions.

Nomination conditions for Feature Classes: The same horse and rider combination may only enter 1 championship class, riders may only enter 2 horses in a championship / series. GDP Children's, Junior, Young Rider, Rising Stars, Future Stars, Amateur, Mini Prix, and Grand Prix. (Note – Foxhunter classes are excluded from this)


Qualifying Series: Points will be allocated for rounds 1 and 2. The leaderboard from Qualifier 1 and 2 will determine the top 40 of entrants in the **Foxhunter** and the top 30 in the **Rising stars** who will be eligible for the final. Placings in the final will determine the overall winner.





It is a privilege that Boneo Park allow us to host this great event on their amazing grounds. The below are conditions of entry at Boneo Park and we ask you all to abide by these.

The Boneo Park Equestrian Centre is an exclusive, private facility and in the interests of ensuring the enjoyment and safety of all users the following code of conduct applies.

Management at Boneo Park can use discretion at any point in time to determine access to the facilities and are not limited to the code below.



PERSONAL CONDUCT

A person may not • use indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening language • behave in an offensive or indecent manner • cause serious alarm or affront to a person by disorderly or unsafe conduct • obstruct a person in the performance of that person's work or duties • Boneo Park management do not tolerate the use, transfer or possession of illegal drugs on the premises. • Anyone found using, transferring or in possession of any non-prescribed illegal drug will be ejected and may be handed over to the police.

RIDING CONDUCT

Approved and tagged safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding • The FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse must be abided by at all times • Smooth soled and heeled boots are worn. • Riding of unsaddled or unbridled horses is prohibited • Alcohol must not be consumed prior to riding • Arena etiquette is observed eg: • Left hand to left hand • Walking give right of way • Diagonal changes have right of way • Uncontrolled horses are removed from the arena

RIDER WAIVERS

Any riders who have not entered an Event at Boneo Park in the past 12months MUST come to the office to fill out a waiver before riding. Riders will be checked.

Generally this is processed electronically when entering Boneo Park own events, however as GDP Classic Incorporated is a separate entity manual waivers will need to be filled out for any riders who have not competed at Boneo Park in the previous 12 months.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash and under effective control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in warm up or competition arenas.
